

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON LAKES, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

* * * * *

WHEREAS, The Mayor is the primary and legal authority for the leadership and direction of Emergency response to all hazard threats to public health and safety and the order and discipline with the community under Federal and State Law, and

WHEREAS, because the City of Weston Lakes, Texas (the "City"), does not have an emergency management staff for the assessing, planning, reaction to and recovery from the devastation and interruption of life as a result of natural and manmade emergency events a volunteer committee is considered necessary to ensure the ability of the City government to direct the preparation, reaction, and recovery from such events; and

WHEREAS, an volunteer Emergency Management Committee (the "Committee") is an appropriate organization of the City to provide for the continuity of emergency management for the city residents in all phases of preparation, coordination reaction and recovery, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WESTON LAKES, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. That an Emergency Management Committee will be established for the purpose of providing direction for the planning, coordination, reaction, and recovery for required response for all hazard emergency situations facing the city and its residents.

Section 3. The committee will be made up of permanent members serving on the Committee based upon their position within the Community. The Committee will be lead by the Mayor as the statutory Emergency Management Director, supported by the Emergency Management Coordinator (Mayor Pro Tem) and the Assistant Emergency Coordinator (Marshal). Other permanent members are: The President of the POA, the Director of MUD 81, the manager of the Country Club, a Commissioner from ESD #4 and a weather advisor. The Mayor and each Council Member will appoint a volunteer resident to serve on the Committee.

PASSED AND APPROVED by a vote of four "ayes" in favor and no "nays" against on this first and final reading on the 24th day of March, 2009.
